The Department of Fire/EMS is seeking a qualified EMS professional to oversee the Emergency Medical Services administrative, training and quality assurance component for the department. This position will work independently and will develop and manage all elements of a metropolitan fire-based EMS system operating within a combination staffed agency.

On a typical workday this position will work with field providers, supervisors and allied medical personnel and agencies to monitor quality assurance, develop EMS policy and represent the department as the senior level EMS officer. The selected individual will coordinate/deliver EMS training, coordinate the ongoing credentialing of personnel, serve as the infection control officer, and provide oversight to the countywide ALS/BLS delivery system.

The ideal candidate for this opportunity will understand fire-based EMS systems and be able to perform all elements of systems administration to include quality assurance, credentialing, and ongoing interface with local medical facilities the state EMS agency (MIEMSS), the National Registry of EMTs and other allied agencies.

5. Current Maryland/MIEMSS licensure as a Paramedic
6. Current Certification as a Maryland Emergency Services Instructor-Evaluator by the MD Instructor Certification Review Board (MICRB)**
7. Completion of a MIEMSS approved quality assurance management program**
8. Requires federal and state criminal background check as condition of employment
