GENERAL RESPONSIBILITIES Performs service, repair and maintenance on county owned automobiles, trucks, and road equipment, including operations on vehicles covered by Federal and State Transportation Regulations.

ESSENTIAL TASKS include the following; other duties may be assigned.

1. Perform major and minor preventative maintenance service on county vehicles and equipment
2. Perform Maryland Department of Transportation (DOT) safety inspections
3. Diagnose and repair mechanical problems
4. Weld and perform minor fabrication work
5. Maintain clean, orderly, and safe work environment
6. Report to work outside of normal hours for emergency operations
7. Perform related duties as to specific assignments
8. Any employee may be identified as Essential Personnel during emergency situations
9. Provide service to customers by answering questions, providing information, making referrals, and assuring appropriate follow-through and/or resolution
10. Communicate with managers, supervisors, co-workers, citizens, and others, maintains confidentiality; and represents the County
