GENERAL RESPONSIBILITIES Provides technical design for and oversees completion of improvement projects for the Carroll County watershed management plan in accordance with Federal, State, and local laws.

ESSENTIAL TASKS include the following; other duties may be assigned

1. Apply principles and practices of engineering, hydrology, hydraulics, limnology, and fluvial geomorphology for evaluation, design, and construction of watershed improvement projects
2. Research, compile and evaluate data for watershed management projects and programs
3. Propose, plan, and design projects to address watershed issues
4. Design and manage construction projects for stormwater management facilities
5. Work with Board of County Commissioners and State/local/Municipal agencies on watershed restoration issues and projects
6. Apply GIS technology to watershed management and projects
7. Conduct field investigations and assessments of biological, chemical, and other aspects of watershed restoration
8. Provide project leadership and management
9. Apply principles, practices, laws and regulations for watershed restoration management
10. Compile reports required by management or other governmental agencies
11. Address errors and complaints
12. Perform related duties as to specific assignments
13. Any employee may be identified as Essential Personnel during emergency situations
14. Provide service to customers by answering questions, providing information, making referrals, and assuring appropriate follow-through and/or resolution
15. Communicate with managers, supervisors, co-workers, citizens, and others, maintains confidentiality; and represents the County
